Each one must sacrifice a great deal more in terms of time, frustration, confusion, learning and other stresses that a larger staff might not have encountered. Nonetheless, upon completion of such a monumental task, there hopefully will be greater satisfaction and pride, shared by these few. Our production met with many unforseen difficulties. First, there were the problems of learning to use a new fully digital publishing approach. Then came the communication problems encountered with our printers.
