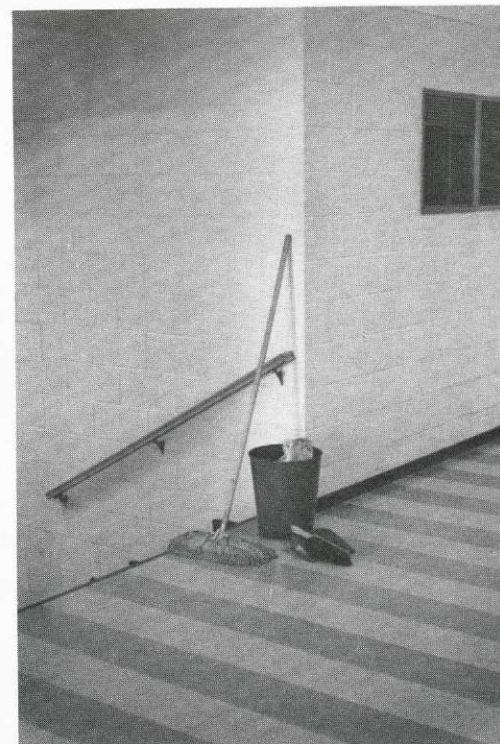
SECRETARY
