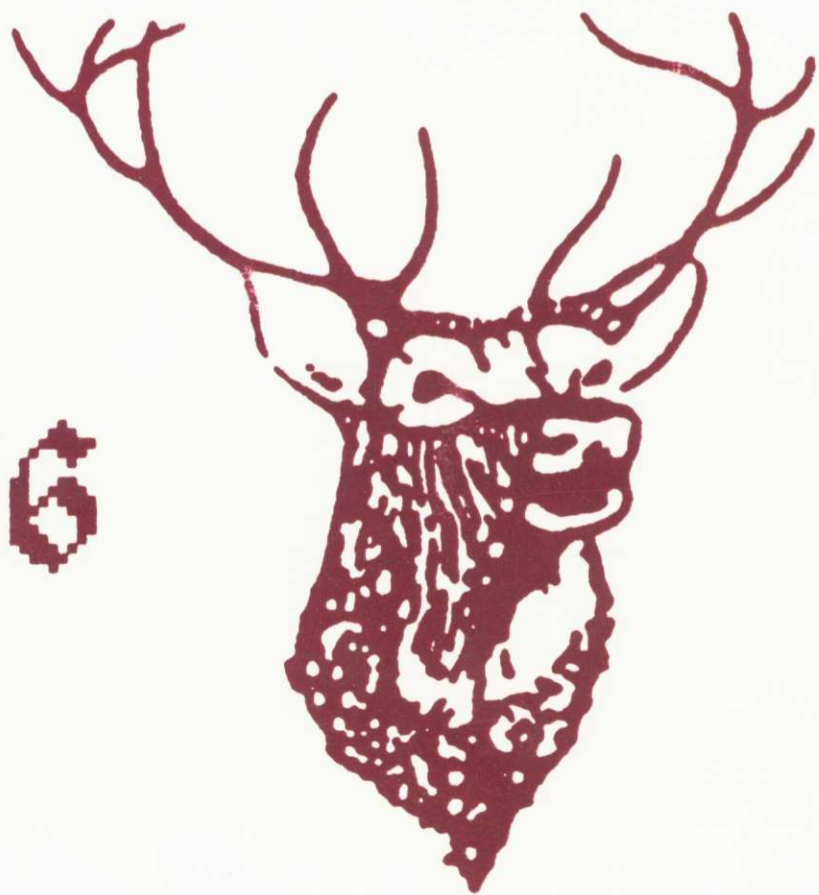

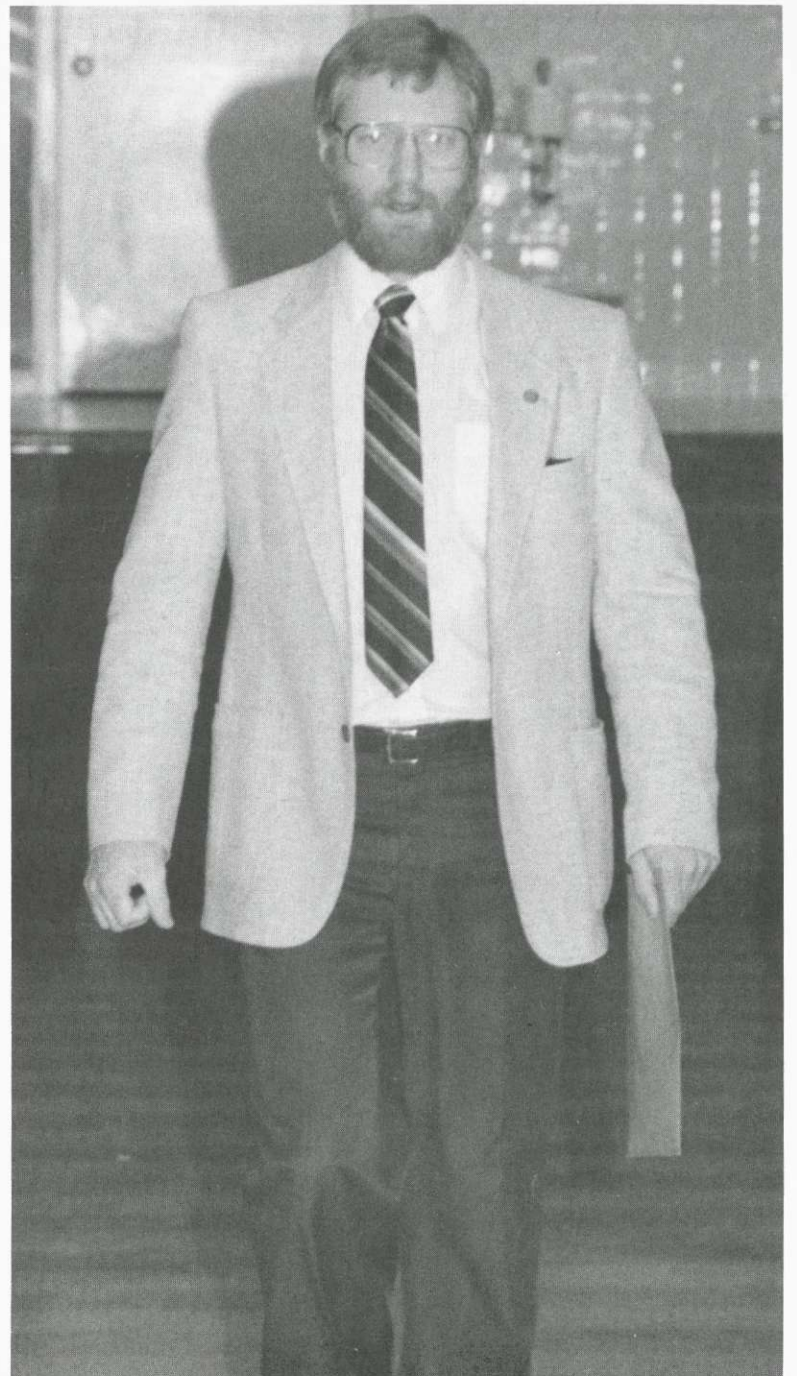

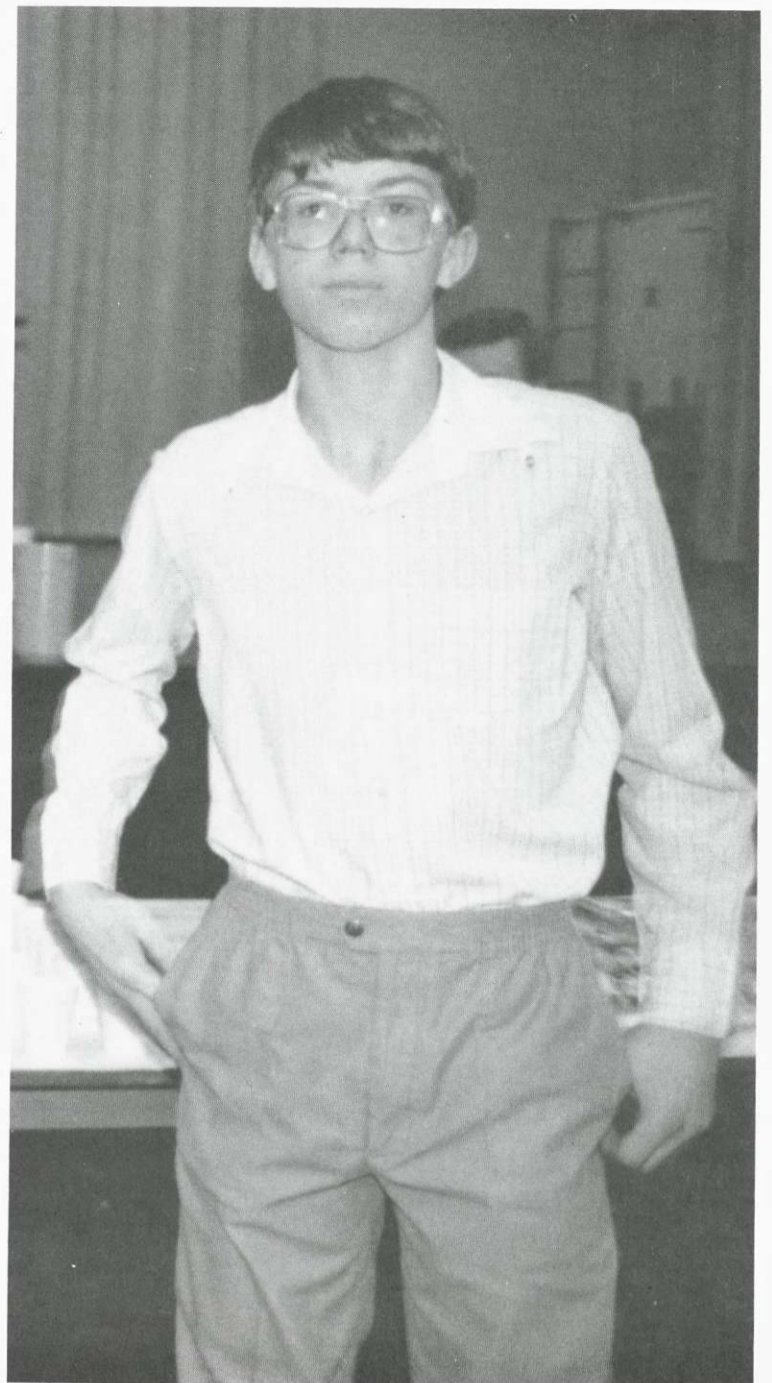


President's Message
