Junior High Volleyball

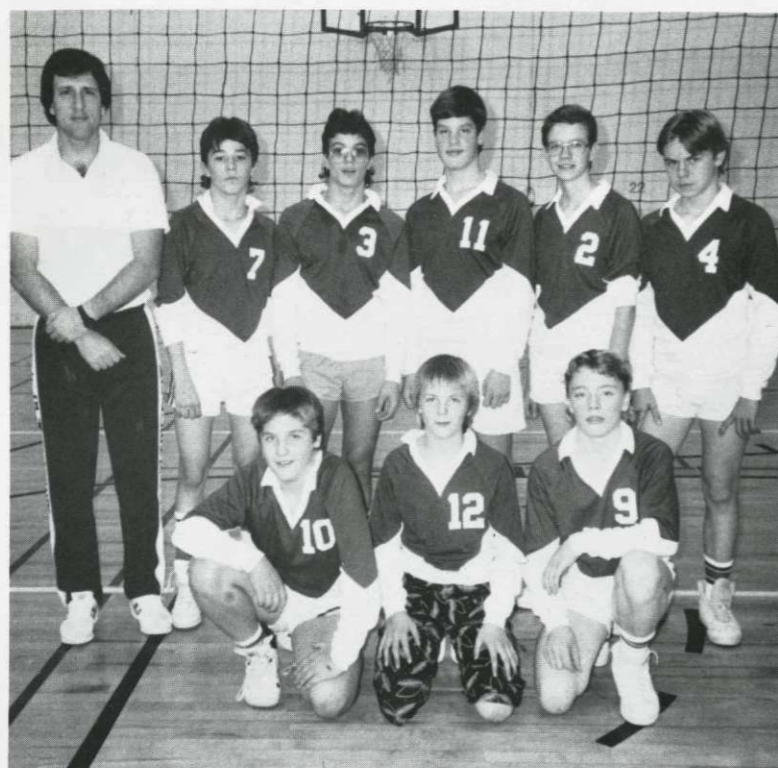

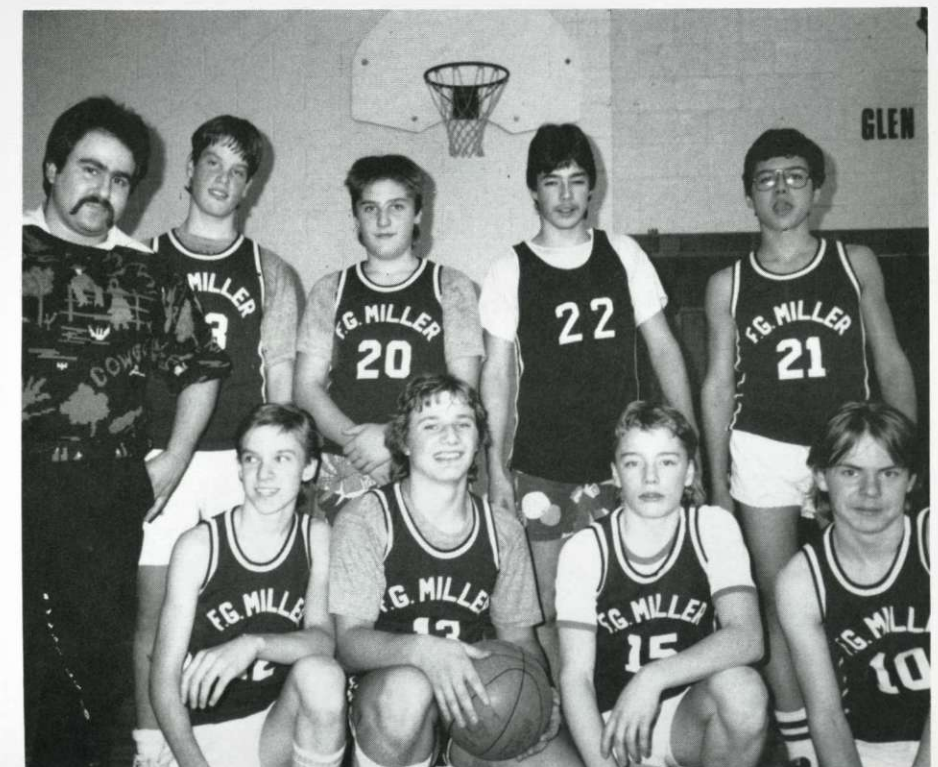

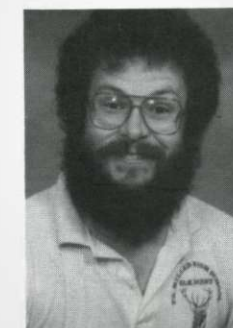


Senior High Badminton

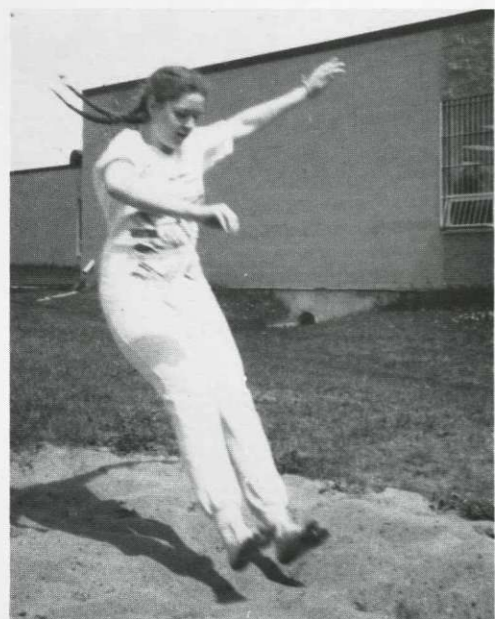
