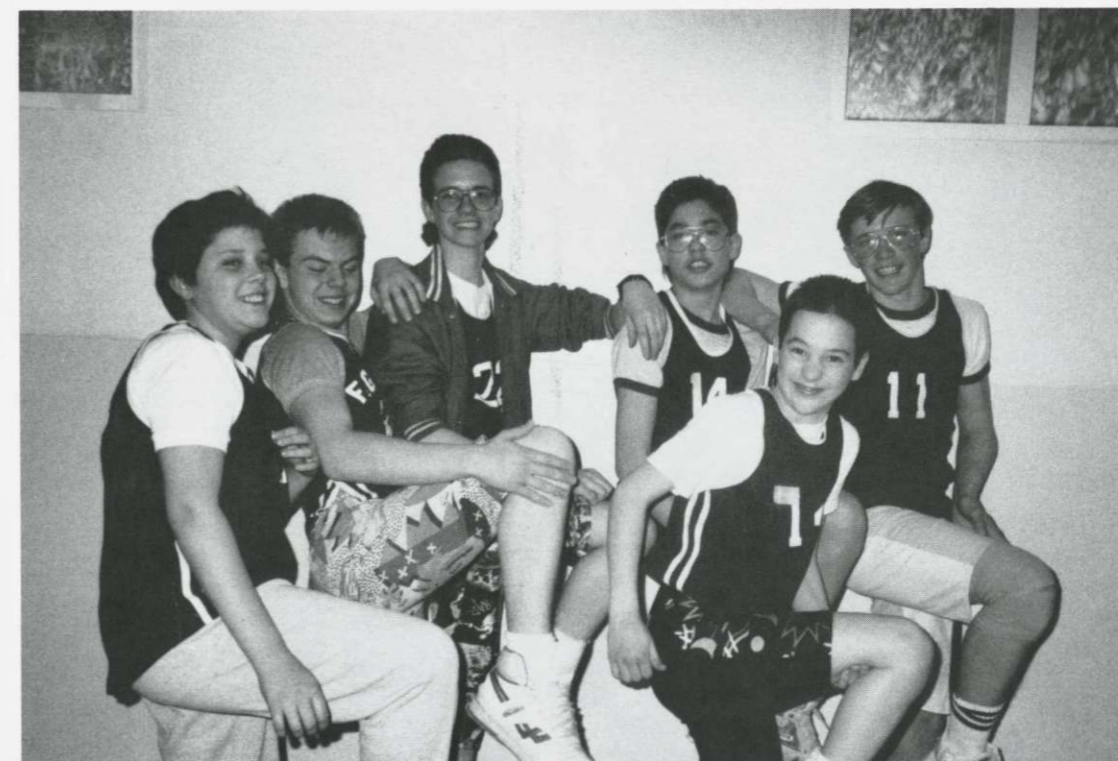
Senior Boys' Volleyball
