The Senior Boys succeeded in defeating Regional High to win the County Cup in Heinsburg on May 29.



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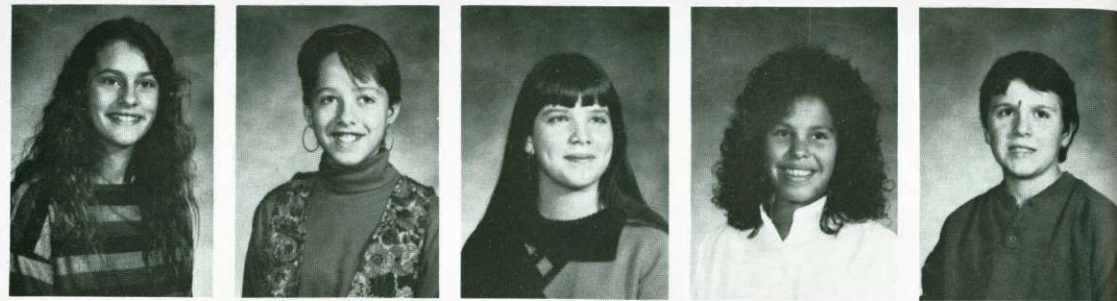

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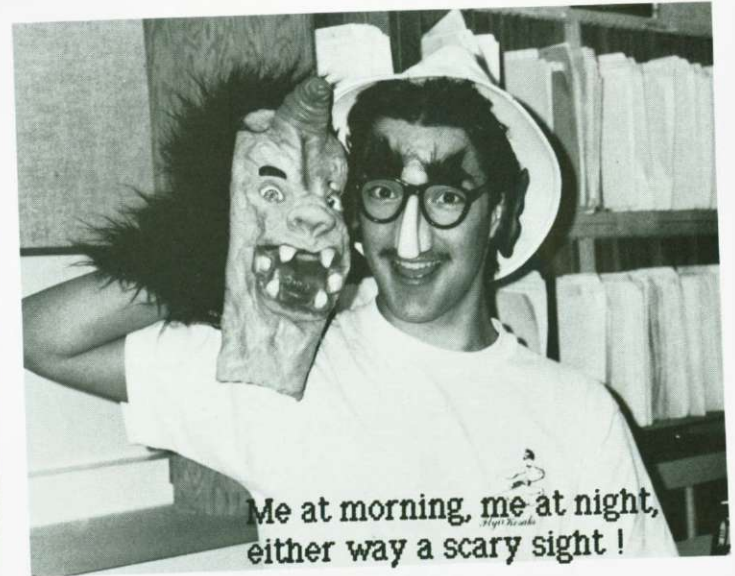
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HALLOWEEN

The school received tremendous support from the community businesses and individuals for the awards. A big thanks to all our sponsors.

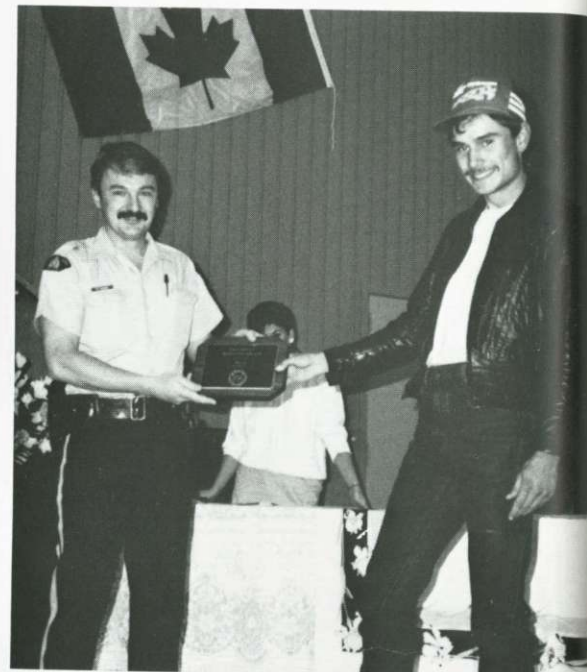
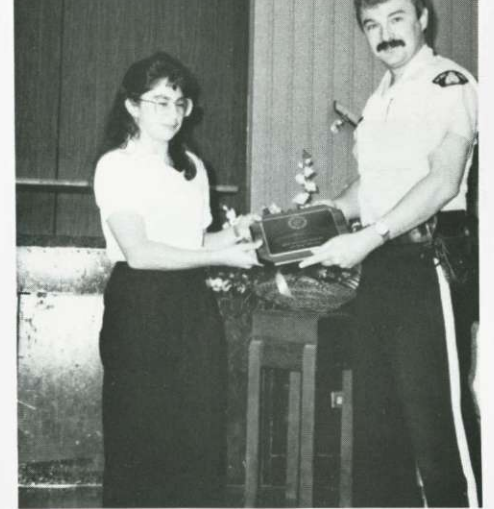

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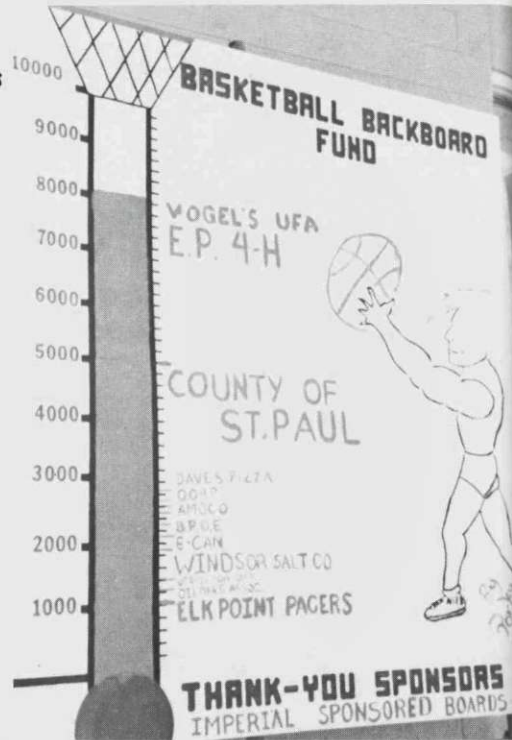
BASKETBALL BACKBOARD FUNDRAISER

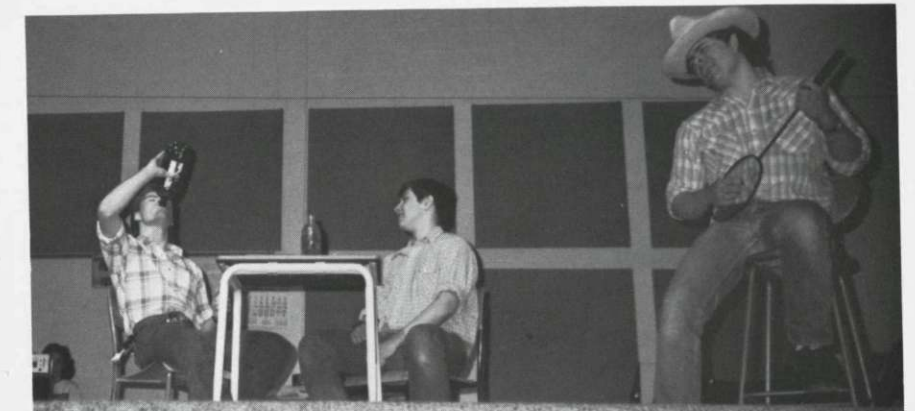

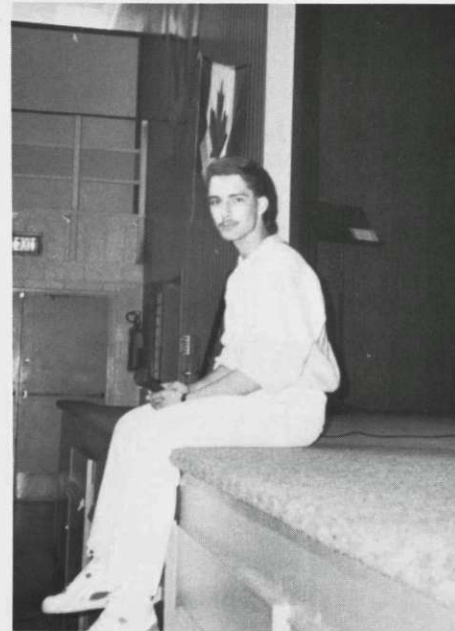
Last year, the senior volleyball team approached Sheldon for a school mascot. They asked for something barbarian-like. They got Mr. Crusader, the knight in shining armor.
