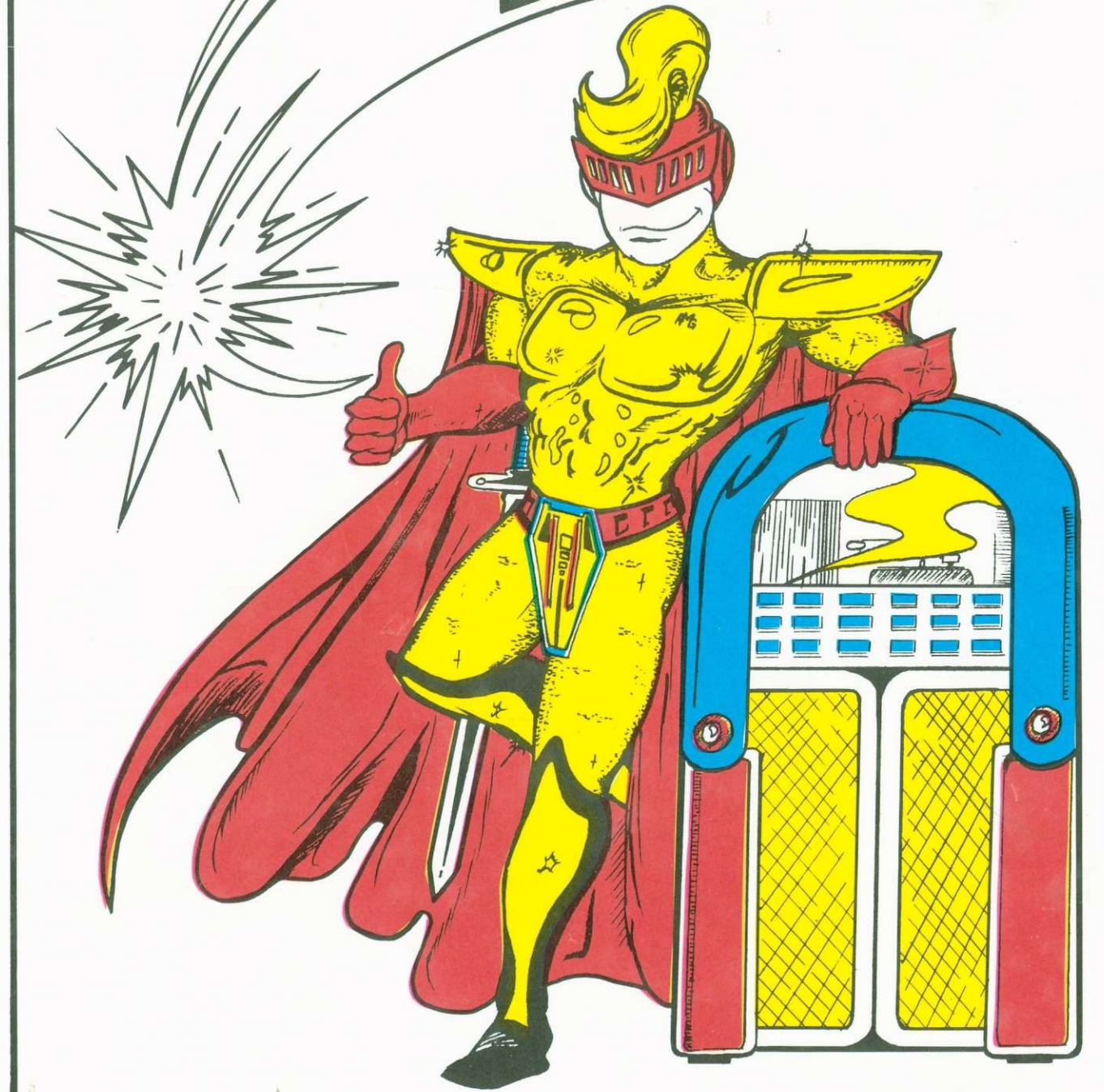

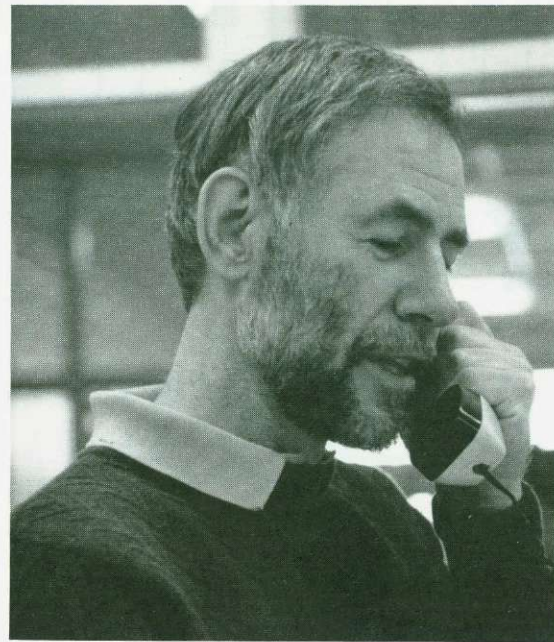

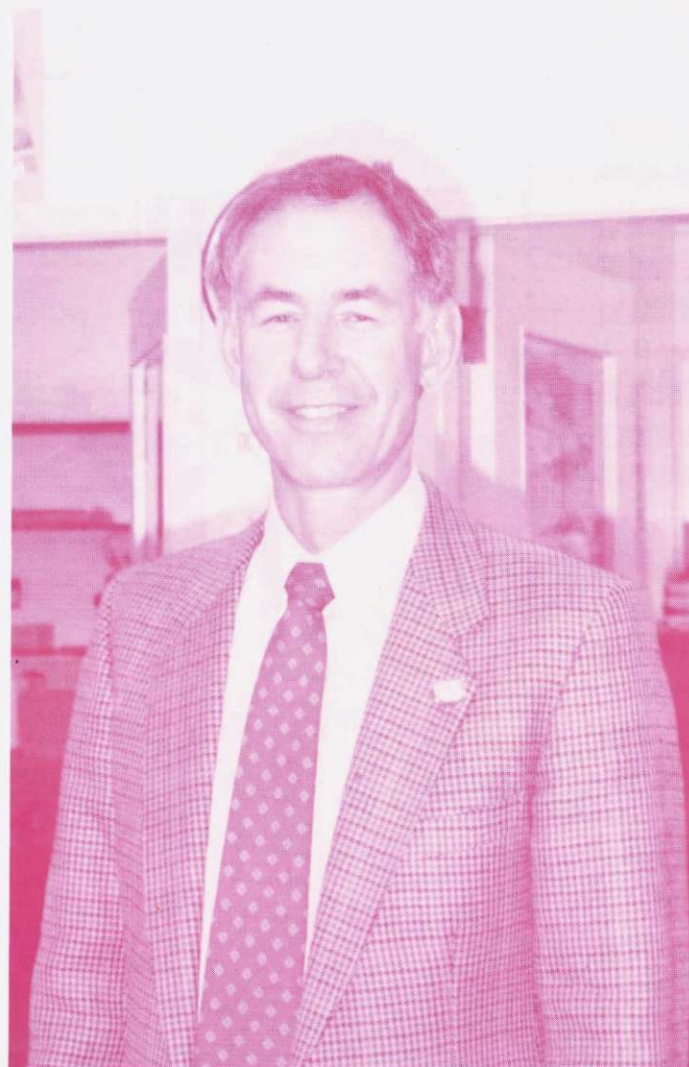
While going to high school and college I did not realize how significant yearbooks would become for me. At the time, I found them fun and interesting, but not valuable.

Although the 1990 Football season was a disappointing one for the St. Paul Lions, the Elk Point Connection did provide some valuable contributions. Second year veteran Roger Smith returned to the team and was moved from a lineman role into the new position in the backfield as a running back.

The emergence of three first-year rookies--Jason Pankiw, Kelly Harms, and David Smith provided to be quite the addition. Jason won a starting position as a tight end on the offense. Kelly played both defensive half back and corner back. David started as a back-up lineman who eventually won a starting assignment at defensive end. 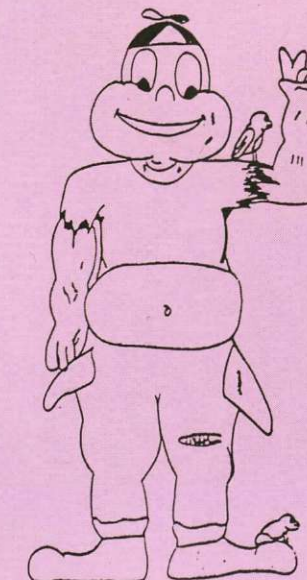
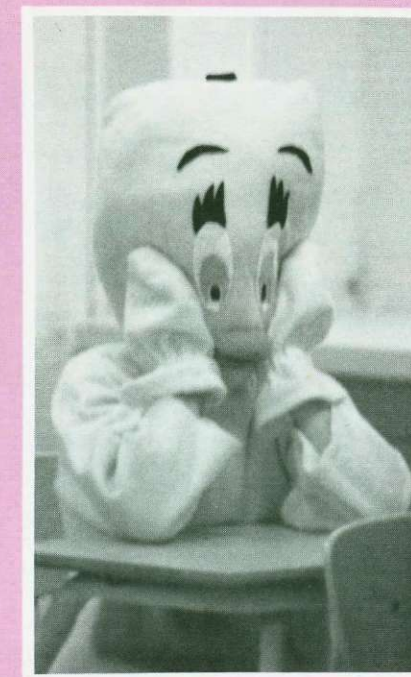
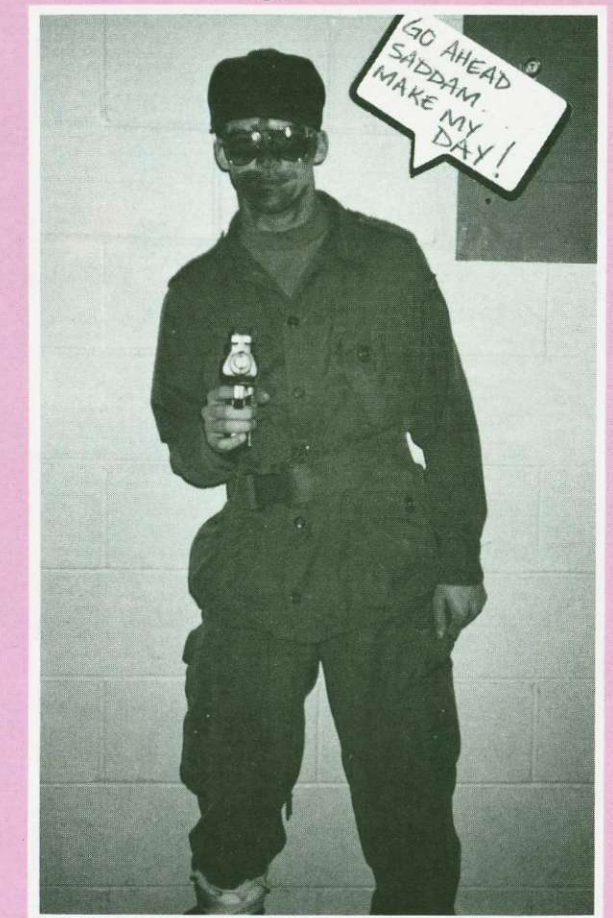
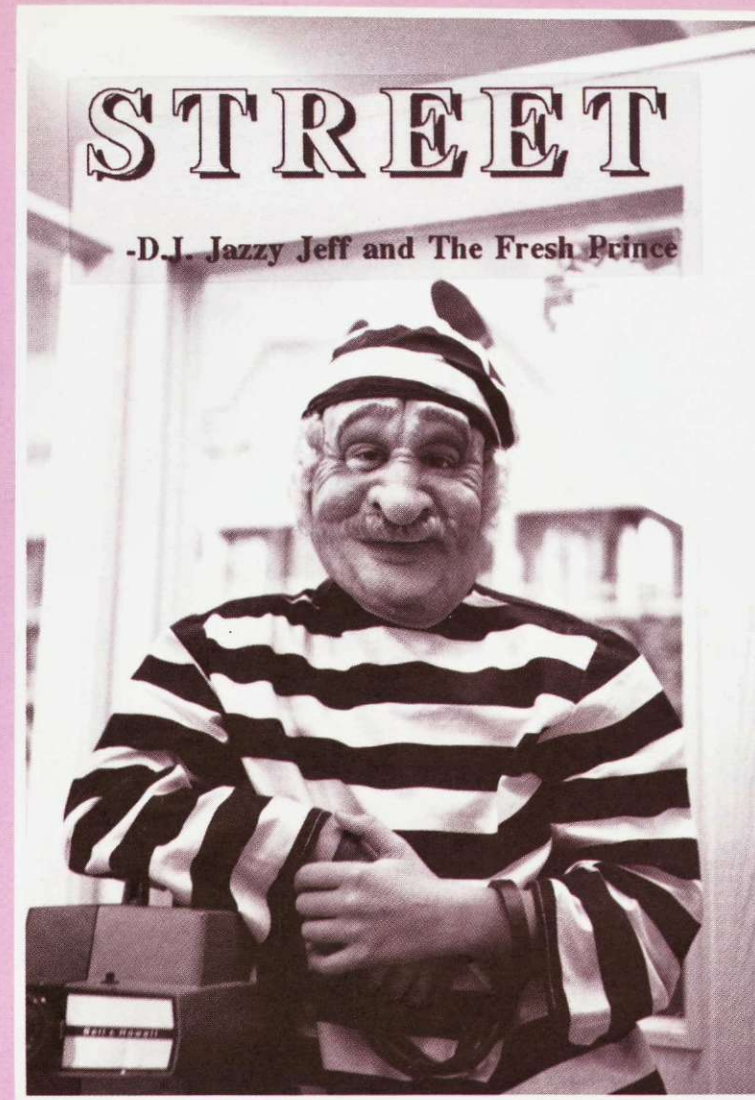
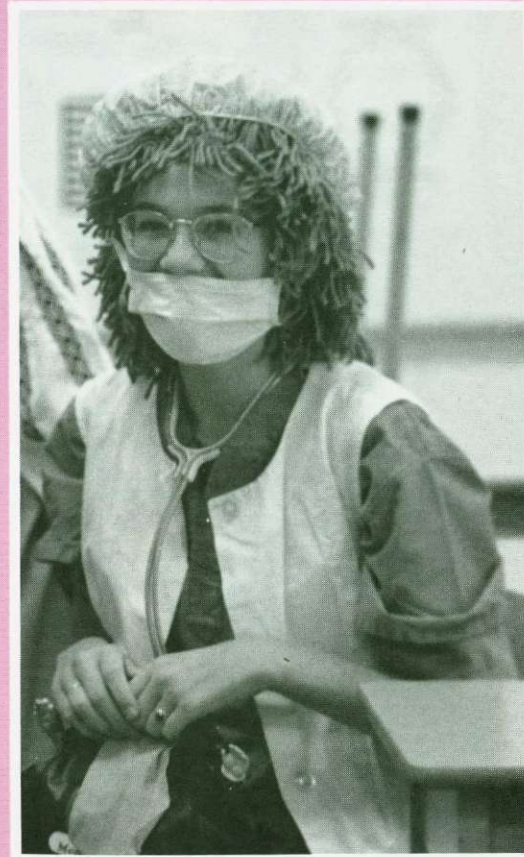
The afternoon portion of our Activity Day was spent in the gymnasium where everyone was entertained by a humorous, yet dynamic, air guitar contest.

We would like to congratulate all the winners and thank everyone for participating. Hopefully next year's Activity Day will be even better.

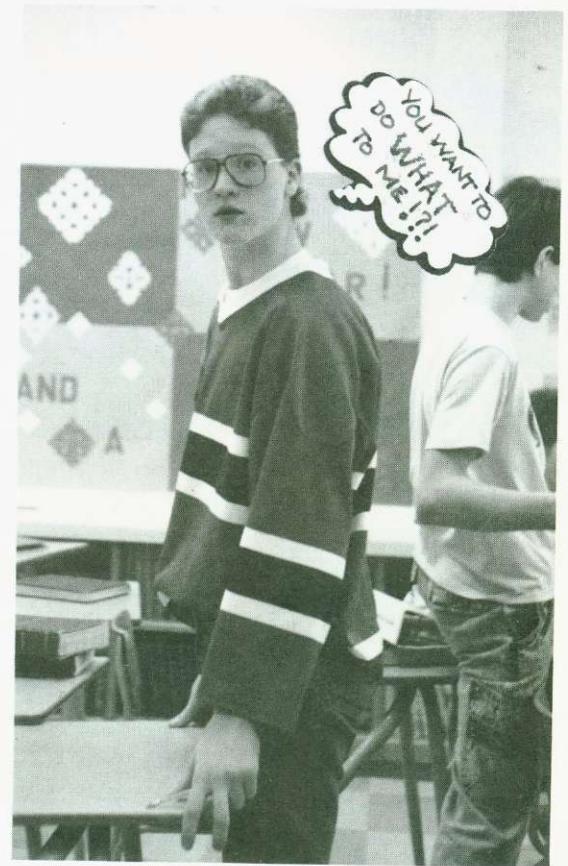

This year's talent show boasted a variety of talented artists. The show was divided into three categories; prizes were awarded for the top contestant from each category. The categories and their winners were:

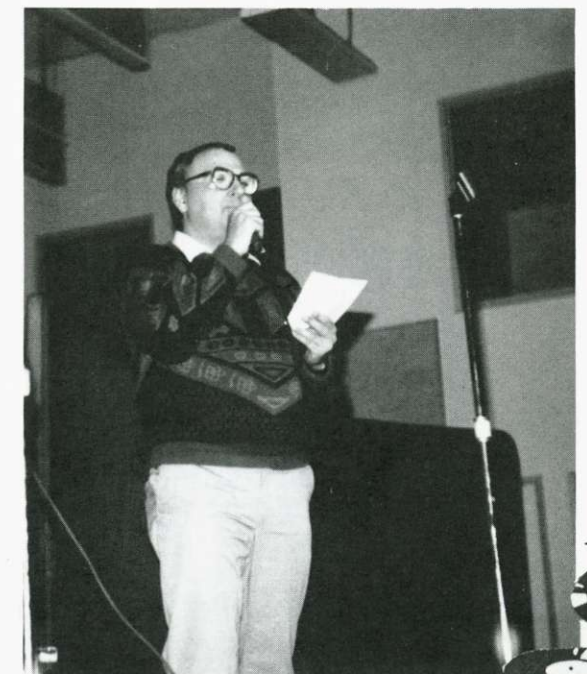
