
MURDER AT F.G. MILLER








Mrs. Wasylik read some of the documents that were found.

"Whatever you do in life, make sure you choose something you enjoy and then do it to the very best of your ability."





NATIVE AWARENESS DAY

The morning was fun and exciting for all. We may look forward to the next Native Awareness Day!









REACHING FOR THE STARS
