Damion Pelletier, Mr. Casper, and Mr. Burke tell the students how drunk driving affected their own lives in different ways.

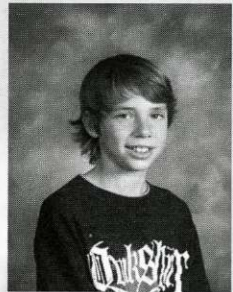

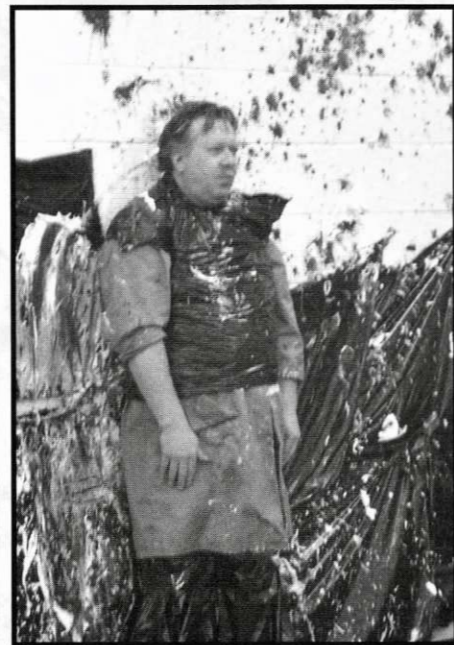
Madame Pentek

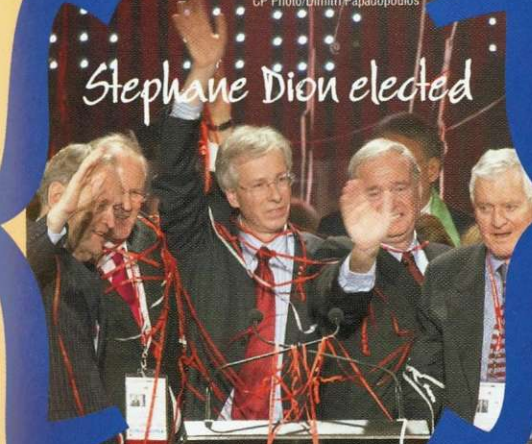

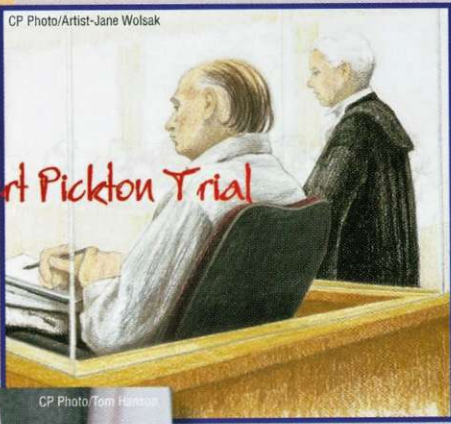

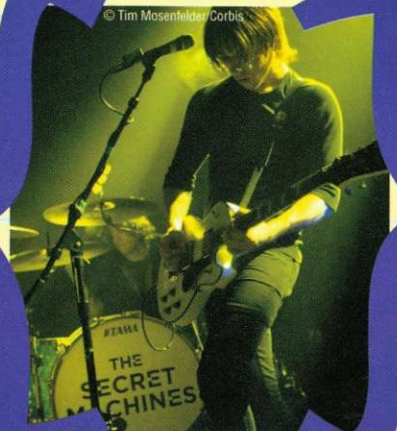
