Playing for Fun and Fitness

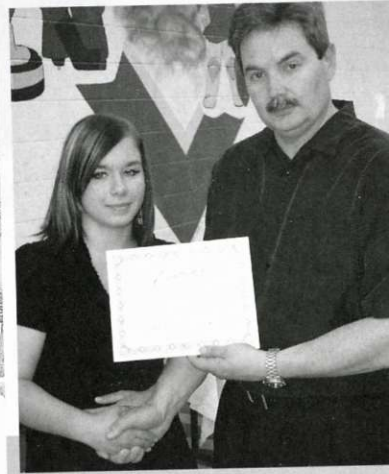
